February 16-18, 2018

The J. Kiffin Penry **Neurostimulation for Epilepsy** program is a weekend course that provides up-to-date instruction on the use of neurostimulation for the treatment of epilepsy. In addition to instructional lectures and workshops, participants also have the opportunity to interact with nationally known faculty and other participants in small group sessions and case studies. The **February 16-18** program is open to practicing physicians.

Expenses for the program, including tuition, meals, airfare and lodging, will be provided by the J. Kiffin Penry Epilepsy Education Programs through educational grants from LivaNova and NeuroPace. Participants will be responsible for the cost of ground transportation to and from the airport and any baggage fees the airlines may impose. The opening lecture begins at 7:30 pm on Friday, February 16th. This will be followed by a reception to afford participants a chance to meet one another and the faculty. The program ends at noon on Sunday. Please see the enclosed course overview for more details.

A limited number of candidates will be accepted to the program, and qualified applicants will be accepted in the order their applications are received.
